**Subject: Invitation to Apply for Ad Hoc Sustainable Groundwater Planning Advisory Committee by  
September 25, 2020**

Dear Valued Stakeholder,

Groundwater is the primary water source for Pajaro Valley residents and businesses. The Pajaro Valley's growth and reliance on groundwater has led to long-term overdraft of the basin, caused seawater to intrude into freshwater aquifers, and has had other impacts such as groundwater quality degradation. The Pajaro Valley Groundwater Basin is designated, per the 2014 Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA), as a critically overdrafted, high priority groundwater basin.

In response to the requirements of SGMA, the Pajaro Valley Water Management Agency (PV Water) will be updating the 2014 Basin Management Plan Update (BMP) to the BMP: Groundwater Sustainability Update 2022 for submittal to the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) by January 2022.

To engage stakeholders and interested parties in the update effort, PV Water is forming an Ad Hoc Sustainable Groundwater Planning Advisory Committee (Committee) to evaluate technical information presented by staff and consultants related to the existing and projected conditions of the groundwater basin, consider sustainable management criteria that would avoid significant and unreasonable impacts to the groundwater basin, and make recommendations to the PV Water Board of Directors (Board).

The Board appointed three PV directors as well as nine additional voting representatives from the organizations below to serve on the Committee:

Aromas Water District	County of Monterey	Farm Bureau of Monterey
California Water Service Company	County of Santa Cruz	Farm Bureau of Santa Cruz
City of Watsonville	County of San Benito	Pajaro Sunny Mesa Community Services District

In addition, the Committee will select five additional voting members through an application process to represent 1) Agriculture, 2) Disadvantaged Community Groups, 3) Environment, 4) Mutual Water Companies, and 5) Rural Residential Well Owners. Interested individuals who can commit to ten 2-hour meetings though October 2021 are encouraged to complete the enclosed application for an open selection process to fill one of the five seats by September 25, 2020.

The appointed Committee will select the five additional members at the first meeting, tentatively scheduled for October 14, 2020, 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm by teleconference. Regardless of selection, interested parties are highly encouraged to attend and participate in all Committee meetings.

Thank you for your continued engagement in working toward groundwater sustainability and for considering to join this important Committee.

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## **APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE AD HOC SUSTAINABLE GROUNDWATER PLANNING ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

The Pajaro Valley Water Management Agency (PV Water) is developing the Basin Management Plan: Groundwater Sustainability Update 2022 (BMP: Groundwater Sustainability Update) which will outline a path to sustainable groundwater resources in the Pajaro Valley by 2040 to maintain compliance with the 2014 Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA). The BMP and associated documents were approved by the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) as an Alternative to a Groundwater Sustainability Plan in July 2019. The BMP: Groundwater Sustainability Update will address ten DWR recommendations regarding sustainable groundwater management. The result of this effort will be submitted to DWR for evaluation by January 2022, following a period of public review and Board direction. To guide the update, PV Water has formed an Ad Hoc Sustainable Groundwater Committee (Committee) to evaluate technical information presented by staff and consultants related to the existing and projected conditions of the groundwater basin, consider sustainable management criteria that would avoid significant and unreasonable impacts to the groundwater basin, and make recommendations to the PV Water Board.

The Committee will be comprised of 17 voting members, 12 appointed, and 5 selected through an open application process. The composition of the Committee is structured to provide a diverse representative cross-section of community stakeholder interests, as well as incorporate water managers within the Pajaro Valley. Attendance and engagement at Committee meetings by the public and other interested parties is highly encouraged to provide input. Voting seats are dedicated to individuals serving as representatives for the Committee members listed below:
