



PAJARO VALLEY WATER MANAGEMENT AGENCY APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO AD HOC FUNDING COMMITTEE

The Pajaro Valley Water Management Agency (PVWMA) is initiating the effort to establish a new rate structure in 2015 to fund the Agency. PVWMA is forming an Ad Hoc Funding Committee (Committee) to allow the Pajaro Valley community to help guide the development of the new rate structure and serve as advisors to the PVWMA Board of Directors with input from the rate payers. The purpose of the Committee is to develop a recommended rate structure that supports the implementation of the Updated Basin Management Plan and work of the PVWMA to mitigate long term groundwater overdraft, stop seawater intrusion, and protect water quality.

In order to allow all of the stakeholders to participate equally and to ensure a balanced and representative cross-section of the Pajaro Valley community, PVWMA is undergoing a Committee application process. Interested Committee members are invited to submit the application for consideration and participation as a Committee member. All Committee meetings are open to the public, so interested stakeholders may choose to participate in the process without requiring application as a Committee member. Committee members are being asked to commit to an 18 to 24 month process. The PVWMA Board of Directors appointed directors Dave Cavanaugh (chair), Amy Newell and Paul Faurot to the Committee and requested that they determine the make-up of the full committee:
