



APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE AD HOC

ADAPTIVE MANAGEMENT PLAN COMMITTEE

The Pajaro Valley Water Management Agency (PV Water) is developing an Adaptive Management Plan (AMP) for the College Lake Integrated Resources Management Project (Project). The mitigation monitoring and reporting program adopted as part of the College Lake FEIR includes Mitigation Measure BIO-2i. (Develop Adaptive Management Plan for College Lake Waterfowl Management and Multi-Species Mitigation). Adaptive management is defined by the state of California as a framework and flexible decision-making process for ongoing knowledge acquisition, monitoring, and evaluation leading to continuous improvements in management planning and implementation of a project to achieve specified objectives.¹

Appointed Ad Hoc Adaptive Management Plan Committee members may include regulatory representatives from state and federal resources agencies such as National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS), Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB), and California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW). Applicant stakeholders will include representatives from the community as noted in the list below.

PV Water anticipates four meetings of the Committee through fall 2021. Meeting objective are described in greater detail in the attached AMP Memo (attached). All meetings will be open to the public, however voting authority will be limited to the Committee members.

The Committee will be comprised of 15 voting members, six appointed, and nine selected through an open application process. Attendance and engagement at Committee meetings by the public and other interested parties is highly encouraged to provide input. Voting seats are dedicated to individuals serving as representatives for the Committee members listed below:
