GENERAL NOTICE

Pajaro Valley Water Management Agency (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

College Lake Water Treatment Plant and Intake Facilities
Project Number 30-39-501

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the Owner's main office located at 36 Brennan Street, Watsonville, CA, 95076, until Tuesday, January 10, 2023, at 10 a.m. local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

Construction of a new intake structure which consists of an adjustable weir, fishway, and intake pump station at College Lake, a raw water conveyance pipeline, and a new water treatment plant including ballasted flocculation/sedimentation, disinfection, treated water pumping, chemical storage and feed, solids handling lagoons, and treatment support building.

Bids are requested for the following Contract: 30-39-501

Owner anticipates that the Project's total bid price will be approximately \$43 Million. The Project has a duration of 670 calendar days.

OBTAINING THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS

A full set of Bidding Documents is available for examination at the office of the Pajaro Valley Water Management Agency. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

PRE-BID CONFERENCE

A mandatory pre-bid conference for the Project will be held on Wednesday, December 7, 2022 at 10 a.m. at 76 Holohan Rd, Watsonville, CA 95076. Bids will not be accepted from Bidders that do not attend the mandatory pre-bid conference.

CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION

Contractor must provide proof of registration with the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) in the form of a PDF extract from DIR Public Works Registration website.

In accordance with California Labor Code Section 1770, et seq., Contractor and subcontractor must submit certified payroll records (CPRs) to the Labor Commissioner.

In accordance with California Labor Code Section 1771.4, the project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the California DIR.

PREVAILING WAGE RATES

Pursuant to Section 1770 et. seq., California Labor Code, the successful Bidder shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of California Department of Industrial Relations. A copy of such prevailing rate is on file at the Owner's offices and will be made available for examination during business hours to any party on request. The project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the California Department of Industrial Relations.

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for construction of College Lake Pipeline Project, Project No. 30-39-502 (Project) will be received by the office of the Pajaro Valley Water Management Agency (Owner), 36 Brennan Street, City of Watsonville, California 95076, until 1:00 p.m., local time, on the 10th day of January, 2023. Any Bids received after the specified time will not be considered.

Bids will then be publicly opened and read.

The Project contemplated consists of installation of approximately 31,400 linear feet of 30-inch diameter high-density polyethylene (HDPE) transmission pipeline; 700 linear feet of 12-inch HDPE pipeline; six trenchless construction under Salsipuedes Creek, Highway 129 (three locations), Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission Railroad, and Highway 1; pipeline appurtenances such as blowoffs, air valves, isolation valves, cathodic protection, pavement replacement, traffic control and all associated work as described in the Contract Documents (Work). Engineer's estimate for this Project is approximately \$26 million.

The Work will be completed in all respects on or before September 20, 2024.

Bidding Documents may be examined in Owner's office, Pajaro Valley Water Management Agency, 36 Brennan Street, Watsonville, California 95076.

Copies of the Bidding Documents may be purchased from Watsonville Blueprint, 757 Freedom Boulevard, Watsonville, California, (831) 728-7717. Watsonville Blueprint will maintain a planholders list. Any addenda and official notices will only be delivered to those on the planholders list.

Each Bid must be submitted on the prescribed Bid Form, including all attachments, and accompanied by Bid security as prescribed in the Instructions to Bidders. By submitting a Bid, the Bidder represents that it has carefully examined and investigated the Work site and all Bidding Documents.

All submitted Bids shall verify if the Owner has issued any addenda for this Project. It is the Bidder's sole responsibility to ensure that all addenda requirements are included in the submitted Bid.

The Successful Bidder will be required to furnish the additional bond(s) and insurance prescribed in the Bidding Documents.

In order to Bid and perform public work, the Bidder and Subcontractors shall hold or obtain such licenses as required by State Statutes, and federal and local Laws and Regulations. Bidders and Subcontractors shall hold current public works contractor registration number by

the Department of Industrial Relations at time of bid. Bidders shall hold California Contractors' License, Class A at time of award. The Bidder is required to ensure that all subcontractors listed in the Bid Form and working on this Project hold valid licenses and certifications suitable for their trade. Failure to possess specified license at time of award shall render Bid nonresponsive. Bidder is required to provide with its Bid satisfactory proof of licensure to Owner.

The Work under these Bidding Documents is to be paid for by public funds; therefore, minimum prevailing wage rates published by the State Director of Industrial Relations are applicable. A copy of such prevailing wage rates is available online at www.dir.ca.gov/OPRL/DPreWageDetermination.htm. Refer to paragraph 7.10D of the Supplementary Conditions for more information.

Owner will obtain from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations the prevailing wage rate of per diem wages for workers to be used on the Project. Copies are on file at Owner's office and are available to interested persons on request. Successful Bidder agrees, upon execution of the Agreement, to post a copy at the Site.

The Project will be subject to a Department of Industrial Relations certified labor compliance program.

Payment for the Work accomplished will be made monthly, but part of amount earned will be withheld to ensure performance under the Contract. Substitution of securities for monies withheld is permitted by Contract Documents as an option open to Successful Bidder.

All questions relative to this Project prior to the opening of Bids shall be in writing and received a minimum of ten (10) calendar days prior to the above-stated Bid opening date and shall be directed to:

A Bidder may withdraw a submitted Bid at any time prior to the time of bid opening only by written request to Owner. Unless otherwise required by law, no Bidder may withdraw its Bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the bid opening.

Pursuant to the provisions of California Labor Code Section 6707, each Bid submitted shall contain, as a separate bid item, adequate sheeting, shoring, and bracing, or equivalent method, for the protection of life or limb in trenches and open excavation, exceeding 5 feet,

which shall conform to applicable safety orders. Neither this requirement, nor any payment by Owner for this separate bid item, shall be construed to impose tort liability on Owner, or its employees or agents, for any injury or damage caused by failure of any excavation or protective equipment or methods.

Owner's right is reserved to reject all Bids or any Bid not conforming to the intent and purpose of the Bidding Documents.
