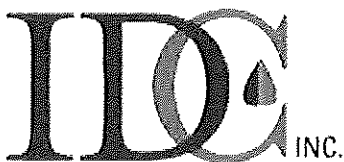

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**CONDITIONS OF SALE / SERVICE / CONSTRUCTION for IDC, LLC.,
Irrigation Design & Construction, LLC henceforth known as "IDC"**

I. ALL TRANSACTIONS

- 1. Payment** - Terms are cash, or net 30 days unless otherwise specified in writing. An additional 1 ½% per month (an annual rate of 18%) will be charged on past due accounts.
- 2. Credit Card Acceptance** – We gladly accept Visa and MasterCard for payment of invoices under \$5,000. We ask that invoices over that amount be paid by check. Fees charged by card issuers make accepting those cards prohibitive for larger payments.
- 3. Prices** - Are subject to change without notice and will be charged at those in effect at the time of delivery.
- 4. Quotations** - Those based on buyer supplied information are subject to change to conform to actual conditions.
- 5. Risk, Damage and Loss** - Damage to, or loss of equipment after delivery is the sole responsibility of purchaser.
- 6. Errors** - Seller reserves the right to correct design, stenographic and clerical errors or omissions.
- 7. Limited Liability** –Seller's liability shall be limited to the stated price of any defective goods or services. IDC shall in no event be liable for buyer's crop loss or damage, lost profits, environmental consequences, or other damages resulting from the use of equipment or services provided.
- 8. Water Quality/Suitability** – IDC neither assumes nor accepts liability for water quality and/or suitability for any purpose. Purchaser is responsible for suitability of water being applied to the crop. IDC does not perform water testing and/or analysis to determine quality or suitability. Water contaminants including but not limited to iron bacteria, high salt loads or high silt/organic loads require special consideration to filter and/or control. IDC will work with the purchaser to filter/control contaminants; however we must be made aware of the contaminants prior to specifying equipment for a project.
- 9. Attorney and Collection Fees** - Buyer agrees that in the event any legal action must be taken to recover unpaid balances there shall be added to said balance(s) reasonable costs of collection including but not limited to attorneys fees and court costs.

II. ADDITIONAL TERMS OF SALE

- 1. Sale** - All sales are final.
- 2. Returns or Cancellations** - Must have prior approval and may be subject to a restocking charge or not accepted.
- 3. Delivery** - Seller reserves the right to make delivery in installments and to invoice as delivered.

III. ADDITIONAL TERMS FOR CONSTRUCTION OR SERVICE WORK

- 1. Underground Excavation** - In the event any excavation encounters rock, hard pan, compacted soil, sand or caving soil, wet soil or water, underground obstacles, or any object contractor deems as out of the ordinary, the owner shall pay contractor's extra cost plus 25%.
- 2. Trenching conditions**- Trenching price does not include the cost of removing berms, uneven ground conditions, etc. The soil surface that is to be trenched is to be smooth and free of obstacles to ensure an even trenching depth, in the event contractor must prepare the soil surface for trenching, owner shall pay contractor's extra cost plus 25%.
- 3. Backfill of Trenches**- Will be consistent with typical agricultural construction; i.e. dependent on soil conditions, proximity of crop, etc. No compaction, hand backfill or water packing will be provided. If owner has special backfill requirements these will be considered extra work.
- 4. Emission Device Location**- Sprinkler, micro-sprinkler, and emitter location will be consistent with typical agricultural installations, i.e. located out of normal tractor driving path, and will be considered subjective in placement by contractor. If customer requires any other location, contractor must be notified prior to starting work and this will be considered extra work.
- 5. Underground Cables, Conduits, etc.** - Owner is required to locate all underground structures. Know before you dig. Call 811 anywhere in the United States at least 48 hours prior to commencement of work.
- 6. Extra Work** – Will be charged at the contractor's cost plus a minimum additional charge of 25%. REVIEW YOUR PLANS AND/OR QUOTE CAREFULLY.
- 7. Withheld Payment** - Where the project is ready for use and/or in use and corrective, repair and/or extra work remain to be completed, the owner may withhold payment of only that amount which is sufficient to pay for completion of such work.

IV. DESIGN SERVICE

1. Unauthorized use of drawings, design information and/or material lists is strictly prohibited. Designs and material lists are the property of IDC and protected by copyright.
2. IDC is NOT a licensed engineering firm. Our designs are based on local knowledge, field experience and the actual use of much of the equipment we install. It is the owner's responsibility to have any and all design work checked by a licensed engineer for accuracy if so desired.
3. Water quality and quantity available for the irrigation system is always subject to varying amounts and varying quality. IDC is not responsible for additional filtration needed, excessive wear on equipment, system re-design and construction, pump replacement or repair, etc. due to information not available, unknown or not relayed to designer.
4. IDC is not responsible for material supplied after manufacturer's warranty has expired. IDC also does not offer any other warranty, implied or otherwise.

V. MECHANIC'S LIEN

1. A mechanic's lien is a hold on the title to a piece of real estate to secure the compensation of those who have performed labor and/or furnished materials to improve the leased property. A lien binds the real property for the value of the labor performed and/or materials furnished similar to the way in which a mortgage or deed-of-trust secures the payment of a promissory note for a loan.
2. A pre-lien notice may be filed in reference to the property. This should not be construed as a statement of the customer's credit worthiness as it is merely a notification that a mechanic's lien COULD EVENTUALLY be filed if payment is not received for goods and services provided. A pre-lien may be required to protect both the property owner and IDC under California law.
